#### **AGENDA:**

Miron called the meeting to order at 12:02 PM. Miron welcomed directors and guests to the October meeting and then opened the floor to this month's special presentation from Eric Wicktor, Pine City Public Schools.

#### **Guest Presentation: Eric Wicktor, Pine City Public Schools**

Wicktor shared some background information on the Career Summit that the school has been hosting for the last five years. The Career Summit brought various businesses into the schools to share their story and path to beginning a career in their chosen field. Students are able to ask questions and learn what steps they need to take. This event was started for the Freshman classes and later expanded to include the Junior class as well.

Wicktor and fellow teacher, Sara Roubinek, are now beginning work on a Job Shadowing Program for Junior and Senior students in Pine City. They are interested in piloting this program for visits to happen in December 2019 and again in the Spring 2020. The goal is to begin opening connections between school, students and the community.

Board member Julie Samuelson inquired about how this program differs from the existing WorkLink program at the high school. Wicktor explained that the job shadowing program is meant to provide an opportunity to experience a future career opportunity – a place that they aren't able to work at as a high school student.

More information on the program as it develops will be shared with the Chamber Office and Schueller will distribute that information as needed to the board members and general membership where appropriate.
